This involves planning an<br>exercise programme for a pregnant client across<br>three trimesters and beyond.<br>The assignments can be submitted at the<br>same time where possible but can be<br>completed separately if preferred.<br>Course work will be marked with 7-days of<br>receipt by post/email. |
| Exam                        |  | One multiple choice exam. It takes 45-minutes<br>and includes 30 questions.<br>The exam can be sat all-year round. Exam fees<br>are included.  |
