Assignments	Assignments are sent one by one and Practice Assignments before Formal Assignments. Feedback available within 5 working days from submission for marking. Assignments and feedback are sent by and to prison staff.
Exam	None Formal Assignments are EQA'd and moderated by the awarding organisation in order to provide the official CMI qualification. These are not sat under exam conditions.
